

By airplane:

The closest airports are at

- Strasbourg (<http://www.strasbourg.aeroport.fr/>)
- Frankfurt/M. (http://www.frankfurt-airport.de/content/frankfurt_airport/de.html)
- Stuttgart (<http://www.flughafen-stuttgart.de/>)
- Baden-Baden (<http://www.baden-airpark.de/>)

From the airports:

Continue either **by train, tram, or car** (see below) **or by shuttle service** (e.g. <http://www.euoline-baden.de/>, unfortunately only in German; as of September 2013, a return ticket for a shuttle service from Strasbourg airport, for instance, costs between 219 € and 280 € in total for up to 8 passengers; the shuttle may wait for other passengers arriving later. There is a specific shuttle service for the Baden-Baden airport, see weblink above)

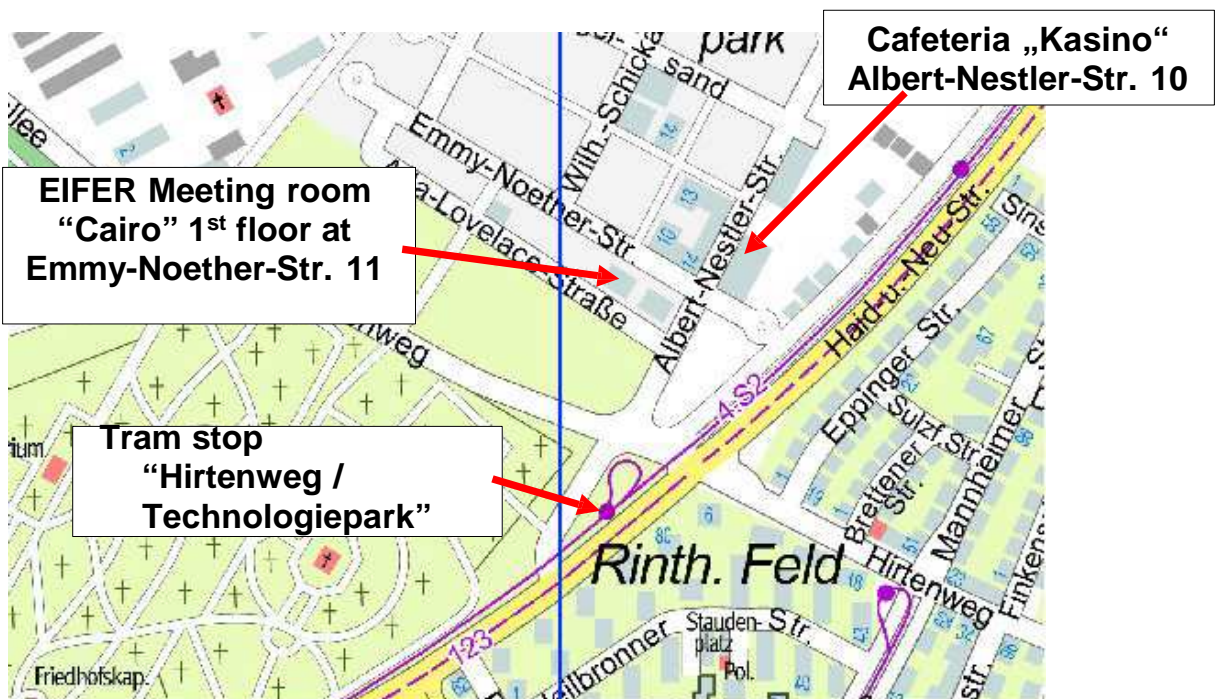
By public transport:

From Karlsruhe Hauptbahnhof (main train station) there is one tram departing in front of the main train station that you can take without having to change:

Tram no.	Direction	Stop to get off	Time of ride
4	"Waldstadt"	"Hirtenweg / Technologiepark"	>20 minutes

You need a 2 zone ticket ("2 Waben"; costs: 2.40€ in 2017). There are special fares for people holding a Bahncard, 1.80€.

By car:

Coming from motorway A5
Exit 44: **Karlsruhe-Durlach**
direction: Stadtmitte

At Ostring / EnBW-building,
Turn right into **Ostring**, direction
Stutensee

At Haid-und-Neu-Straße,
turn right

At the next junction, turn left into
Hirtenweg

Next street, turn right into
Albert-Nestler-Straße

2nd street, turn left into
Emmy-Noether-Straße

Emmy-Noether-Str. 11 is the 2nd
building on your left
